

Aramark Dietetic Internship Program Mission, Goals and Objectives

Mission:

To deliver experiences which develop entry-level registered dietitian nutritionists who enrich and nourish lives

Program Goals and Objectives:

1. The program will prepare graduates to enter the profession as entry-level registered dietitian nutritionists.
 - 80 percent of program graduates take the CDR credentialing exam for dietitian nutritionists within 12 months of program completion
 - The program's one-year pass rate (graduates who pass the registration exam within one year of first attempt) on the CDR credentialing exam for registered dietitian nutritionists is at least 80%.
 - 80% of graduates will develop the skills and abilities for entry-level practice.

2. Graduates will meet the demand for qualified entry-level registered dietitian nutritionists and managers within the Dietetics profession.
 - At least 80% of program interns complete program/degree requirements within 13 months (150% of the program length).
 - Of graduates who seek employment, 80 percent are employed in nutrition and dietetics or related fields within 12 months of graduation.
 - 80% of employers are satisfied graduates developed the skills and ability for entry-level practice.
 - At least 50% of eligible internship graduates will be hired at an Aramark managed accounts within 12 months of program completion.
